- 2 Complete the **Housing Application** and **Room and Board License**, **if living on campus**. These can be accessed on myCampus in the Spring. Questions? Contact Housing at 207.778.7488.
- (3) Complete the **Financial Terms and Conditions Agreement**, located on your "To Do" list in MaineStreet. This must be done before you can be registered for classes.
- 4 Complete the **Course Planning Form** (on myCampus, beginning in April) so that your advisor knows which courses you would prefer on your fall schedule in addition to courses suggested for your major.
- (5) Sign up for Summer Experience (takes place in June) It's a great way to get a jump start to your UMF experience.
- 6 Accept your Financial Aid awards on MaineStreet.
- (7) Review your fall semester bill (July) and set up an authorized user.
- Make sure your final High School transcript and other academic transcripts have been sent, including Dual Enrollment classes, Early College classes, AP exam results, and all college transcripts. **These must be requested by you** and sent directly to the Shared Processing Center, PO Box 412, Bangor, ME 04402.
- (9) Submit your photo for your UMF ID. You will get info from UMaine System Card Services Offices.
- (10) Submit immunization records to farmington/student health.
