Session 1	<p>Prehistoric Pioneers – Mon, June 15th:  Step back to the dawn of time as campers explore the age of dinosaurs, fossils, and early humans! Campers will dig for fossils, create cave art, build mini volcanoes, and play prehistoric-themed games like Dino Tag and Meteor Dodgeball. We'll explore what life was like before cities, technology, and even writing existed. It's a hands-on week of discovery, movement, and imagination! Trips Big and Local: Kineowatha Friday</p>
Session 2	<p>Ancient Civilizations – Mon, June 22nd:  Travel to the powerful civilizations of Ancient Egypt, Greece, and Rome! Campers will build pyramids, design shields, decode hieroglyphics, and compete in Olympic-style challenges. We'll learn how ancient people built massive structures, trained warriors, and created some of the first forms of government and sport. It's a week full of teamwork, problem-solving, and epic challenges! Trips Big and Local: Kineowatha Friday</p>
Session 3	<p>Enter the world of knights, castles, and dragons! Campers will build cardboard castles, design family crests, complete knight training obstacle courses, and go on dragon-themed quests. We'll explore medieval life, teamwork, and what it took to protect a kingdom. Expect lots of imagination, movement, and creative play throughout the week! Trips Big and Local: Kineowatha Friday</p>
Session 4	<p>Age of Exploration – Mon, July 6th:  Set sail with pirates and explorers as campers navigate treasure maps, solve riddles, and complete adventure challenges! Campers will create their own maps, go on scavenger hunts, build ships, and learn about famous explorers and ocean travel. This week is packed with teamwork, navigation games, and high-energy outdoor fun! Trips Big and Local: Kineowatha Friday</p>
Session 5	<p>Wild West & Frontier – Mon, July 13th:  Saddle up for a week of pioneers, cowboys, and frontier survival skills! Campers will try gold panning, learn outdoor navigation, complete pioneer relay races, and explore what life was like on the frontier. We'll focus on teamwork, resilience, and outdoor adventure with plenty of active games and nature-based challenges. Trips Big and Local: Kineowatha Friday</p>
Session 6	<p>Inventors & Industrial Age – Mon, July 20th:  Put on your thinking caps as campers become inventors and engineers! Campers will build simple machines, create mini inventions, explore famous inventors, and solve STEM challenges. We'll learn how creativity and problem-solving helped shape the modern world. It's a high-energy week of building, testing, and hands-on science fun! Trips Big and Local: Kineowatha Friday</p>
Session 7	<p>Modern Day Heroes – Mon, July 27th:</p>

		 Meet the heroes of today—firefighters, first responders, athletes, and community helpers! Campers will take on teamwork challenges, obstacle courses, and fitness-based games while learning what it means to help others and work as a team. This week focuses on leadership, kindness, and being a positive force in the community. Trips Big and Local: Kineowatha Friday
Session 8		 Future Explorers – Mon, August 3rd: Blast into the future with space exploration, robotics, and sustainability! Campers will launch rockets, build simple robots, design futuristic cities, and learn how to protect our planet. We'll imagine what life might look like in 50–100 years and explore how science and teamwork can shape a better future. A perfect way to wrap up an epic summer adventure!
